A public hearing will be held for the purpose of hearing the public and all interested persons concerning the adoption of the 2015 edition of the International Fire Code. The purposes for adopting a fire code are to promote life safety and property conservation, to reduce the chances of fire occurrences and to prevent the loss of life.

If the International Fire Code is adopted, Zeeland Fire Rescue will not charge for a Life Safety Inspection since this is a service which will be provided along with the adoption of a fire code. Inspections will address items which include:


- Ensuring business address numbers are displayed and viewable from the right-of-way;
- Ensuring emergency lights and exit signs are working;
- Ensuring marked exits are not obstructed;
- Ensuring alarms systems are working properly;
- Ensuring automatic fire suppression systems are working properly;
- Ensuring automatic fire suppression system valves are accessible to the Fire Department;
- Ensuring proper clearance to electrical equipment;
- Ensuring combustible materials are not stored next to HVAC equipment;
- Ensuring flammable liquids are not stored too close to a heat source;
- Ensuring fire extinguishers are in a state of readiness;
- Ensuring compressed gas cylinders are secured; and,
- Ensuring compliance with other applicable Fire Code requirements.

Copies of the proposed ordinance to adopt a fire code and the International Fire Code which is being considered for adoption are available for inspection in the City Clerk's Office, in the Howard Miller Library and in Fire/Rescue Services Offices of the City of Zeeland.
